The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a moratorium for Commonwealth charter schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 71, Section 89, subsection (ii) of the General Laws, as appearing
2	in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in its entirety and replacing in place
3	thereof the following:
4	"(ii) No teacher shall be hired by a commonwealth charter school who is not certified
5	pursuant to Section 38G in accordance with all the rules and regulations of the board of
6	elementary and secondary education."
7	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the authority of
8	the board of education to grant commonwealth charters to an applicant pursuant to section 89 of
9	chapter 71 of the General Laws shall be suspended until September 1, 2018.
